Please be aware that the **school cannot supply the texts listed on the Personal Items List**, so if you choose to purchase the items elsewhere, you will still need to buy the textbooks through Champion Education.

Eden Hill's P&C courteously requests a contribution of \$25 per family in order to cover operational costs of our highly successful association. Whilst the P&C supports the school by directing significant finances to assist students each year, initial operational costs of around \$2000 to cover insurance, association fees and charges must be cleared before support can be offered. Your contribution will offset these costs and allow 100% of fundraising to be directed to your school.

If you do not purchase through the school (Champions) you will need to pay for School Amenities, Computing Costs, Athletics and P&C Family contribution at the Office at the start of the year.
